

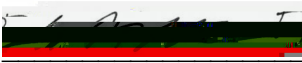
SCHOOL EXCURSION / INCURSION NOTIFICATION

Dear Parent/Caregiver, an excursion/activity has been organised for your child.

Excursion / Incursion	THS Swimming Carnival 2024
Date	Monday 12th February 2024 ((The 200 metre events will start at 8:30am. Main carnival events will start around 9:30am once the buses arrive from school))
Year / classes involved	All students - Yr7-12
Location	Ku-ring-gai Fitness and Aquatic Centre (Prince of Wales Drive, West Pymble NSW 2073)
Purpose	The school's annual swimming carnival is on Monday 12/02/2024
Start time	8:30am Turrumurra High School
End time	2:15pm Returning to Turrumurra High School
Transport	Students can make their own way to and from the carnival, or they may travel by chartered bus, departing Turrumurra High School at 8:40am and returning to school before the end of the day. Parents need to complete the relevant section on the consent form regarding transport. Students without permission to leave the pool will have to catch the bus back to school at the end of the carnival.
Cost	The cost of the carnival is included in the 2024 fees
Dress requirements	Full sports/PE uniform or House colours. It is not a mufti day.
Food	Students bring their own recess/lunch. Please bring plenty of water.
Equipment	Swimwear appropriate for races, water bottle, hat, sunblock and wet weather gear.

Additional information	If it is wet on the morning of the carnival, a decision as to whether the carnival will run for all students will be made by 7:30 am and a message communicated via email. A 'competitors only' carnival will take place for those students wishing to qualify for Zone. These students will need to make their own way to and from the pool. All other students will attend school.
Educational outcomes	It is an OFFICIAL SCHOOL DAY and students are expected to be in attendance. Rolls will be marked at the venue and absentees must bring a note signed by their parent/carer, on the next school day, explaining why they did not attend.
