Purpose	Social Justice Group is once again supporting one of Australia's oldest charities, Legacy Australia, to assist the families and dependents of Australia's veterans. Student volunteers from Social Justice will fundraise at Turrumurra Station and Shops in small groups to sell Legacy badges, pens, wristbands and keyrings to members of the public. Funds raised from this volunteering are used by Legacy Australia to support the families of Australia's veterans with financial, educational and socioemotional support services. <p>Additional information</p>	<p>DATES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Students in Year 11 will only volunteer on the Monday * Students in Years 7-10 will be volunteering on the Monday and Friday. * Students who have another commitment Eg early morning orchestra at school etc are to advise the Supervising Teacher for adjustments to be made. <p>Requirements of Volunteers by Transport NSW</p> <hr/> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Students are NOT permitted on platforms or in the paid concourse area. * Students must be respectful and polite to commuters/customers at all time. * Do not obstruct, block or impede customers in the train station concourse area. * Students must not approach people to make sales, but instead must stay in their designated spot. 'Volunteers must not solicit business in a forward movement into customers'. * Students must keep their area clean and tidy, and clean up after themselves before leaving. <p>Other Information</p> <hr/> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Students will work in pairs or threes. If you don't have a partner, one will be assigned to you from SJG. * One student will carry the fundraising box around their neck; the other will collect money and possess the QR code for virtual payments * Be very careful not to drop / lose badges etc. Sometimes they fall out of the box. * Virtual Payments- If a member of the public wants to pay via the QR code, you MUST see their screen to verify they have paid before giving them the merchandise. * For all virtual payments, record the amount on the provided record sheet to keep track.
