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For the Principaland teachers

Deliver learning experiences that encourage safe, responsible and respectful use of digital devices and online services. This includes:

- Establishing agreed classroom expectations for using digital devices and online servinces with this procedure and departmental policy.
- Identifying strategies to ensure that all students are able to engage in classroom activities, including strategies to accommodate students without a digital device.
- Educatingstudents about online privacy, intellectual property, copyright, digital literacy and other online safety related issues.
- Model appropriate use of digital devices and online services in line with departmental policy.
- Respond to and report any breaches and incidents of inappropriate use of digital devices and online services as required by school procedures, departmental policy and any statutory and regulatory requirements. This includes:
 - i Reporting the creation, possession or distribution of indecentor offensive material to the Incident Support and Report hotline as required by the 'Incident Notification and Response Policy and Procedures' and consider any mandatory reporting requirements.
 - i Workingwith the departmentand the Office of the eSafetyCommissione (if necessary) o resolve cases of serious online bullying and images ed abuse.
 - í Following the school's Behaviou Management plan when responding to any incident of inappropriate student behaviour relating to the use of digital devices or online services.
 - i If feasible, and particularly as issue some rge, support parents/carersto understand strategies that promote their children's safe, responsible and respectful use of digital devices and online services.
 - í Participatein professionadevelopmentrelated to appropriate use of digital devices and online services.
